Working languages of the conference: Ukrainian, English.

Thematic Directions of the Conference:

1. *Innovative development and technological modernization of the economy* as key factors for Ukraine’s sustainable growth amid military confrontation, post-war recovery, and integration into the EU.

2. *Regional aspects of innovative activity:* reconstruction and strengthening of regional economic security, development of clusters, and coordination of government, science, and business efforts in economic recovery.

3. *Creation and development of innovation infrastructure in the context of European integration:* military factors of leadership, harmonization of national and regional innovation systems with evolving EU requirements, and engagement of international partners.

4. *Development of innovative entrepreneurship:* business adaptation to conditions of military confrontation and national reconstruction, support for startups, attraction of investments, and development of modern ecosystems for technological businesses.

5. *Science, education, and industry in the context of Euro-Atlantic and European integration:* expanding opportunities for international cooperation, showcasing cutting-edge scientific and technical developments, and their integration into the industrial sector.

6. *Mechanisms of public administration and legal foundations for Ukraine’s innovative activities as an EU candidate country:* support for innovative enterprises, development of legislative initiatives, and adaptation of Ukrainian law to European standards.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACT FORMATTING

1. Only original abstracts containing previously unpublished research results will be accepted for publication.
2. Abstract length should not exceed 5 pages, including figures, tables, and reference list.
3. Abstracts should be prepared using Microsoft Word, Times New Roman font; size – 12; line spacing – 1.15. Margins: 2 cm on all sides.
4. When formatting the reference list, follow the requirements of the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015. In-text citations should be indicated in square brackets.
5. Header elements: in the first line on the left without indentation – UDC; second line - surname and initials of the author(s); third line - academic title, scientific degree, position, institution (organization), email; fourth line - author's ORCID (if available); after one blank line - the title of the abstract in capital letters (centered). Then, after one blank line – an annotation. On a new line – keywords in the language of the abstract. On a new line – the main text. One blank line after the abstract text should be followed by "References". At the end, for Ukrainian-language abstracts, the following should be provided in English: surname and initials of authors (centered), abstract title (centered, in capital letters), translation of the annotation text and keywords (from a new line, paragraph indentation); for English-language abstracts – all data should be duplicated in Ukrainian.
6. Abstract files and application files should be saved in DOC format. File names should be submitted as: Ivanenko_abstract, Ivanenko_application.

CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

To be included in the conference program, **by May 11, 2025**, you must:

2. After receiving confirmation of abstract acceptance for publication, send a scanned copy of the receipt for the organizational fee payment. Confirmation of abstract receipt should be received within 3 working days; otherwise, contact the organizing committee.

Abstracts submitted to the organizing committee after the deadline will not be considered. The author is responsible for the accuracy of the content. Abstracts are published in the conference proceedings in the author's original version. Abstracts that do not align with the conference's thematic areas, formatting requirements, or quality standards will be rejected, with a corresponding notification sent to the authors' email.
